Skyler just couldn't connect during the second round and scored in only three of the six stations which left an opening for Bill Keller & Ballistic Biggs to jump into first place. They scored at all six stations in both rounds earning an impressive 16 points (19 points possible) on their second round. The Distance Throw was

Instead of stopping and taking the three points, they elected to continue and missed the next two attempts for no points, leaving him one point behind Bob Holmes & Foster.
